PRIVACY POLICY

We at Act Now Foundation, Inc. ("<u>Act Now Foundation</u>," "<u>we</u>," "<u>us</u>," or "<u>our</u>") have created this privacy policy (this "<u>Privacy Policy</u>") because we know that you care about how information you provide to us is used and shared. This Privacy Policy relates to the information collection and use practices of Act Now Foundation in connection with its Site and Services.

By visiting our Site, accessing and/or using our Services, you are agreeing to the terms of this Privacy Policy and the accompanying Terms of Use.

Capitalized terms not defined in this Privacy Policy shall have the meaning set forth in our Terms of Use.

The Information We Collect and/or Receive

In the course of operating the Site, providing the Services and/or interacting with you, Act Now Foundation will collect (and/or receive) the following types of information.

1. Contact Information

When you contact us, sign up to be on our mailing list, book and appointment for our Services, or make a donation through the Site, you will be asked to provide certain information, which may include name, e-mail address, address, and phone number (collectively, "Contact Information"). The Contact Information is used to provide the requested service or information and to contact you for purposes of direct marketing of our current and future services.

2. Volunteer/Intern Information

When you sign up to become a volunteer or intern, you will be asked to provide certain information, including but not limited to, your name, email address, address, phone number, major, preferred start date, days and hours of your availability, school name, resume (if applicable), cover letter (if applicable), and position you are applying for (collectively, the "Volunteer/Intern Information"). We will use Volunteer/Intern Information to determine whether you are a good fit for our organization and to contact you about the applicable volunteer and/or internship opportunities.

3. Billing Information

In order to make a donation, you will be required to provide certain additional information which may include a credit card number, expiration date, billing zip code, activation code, bank information, and similar information ("Billing Information"). Such Billing Information will be

collected and processed by our Third Party Payment Processor pursuant to the terms and conditions of their privacy policies and terms of use. Act Now Foundation does not directly obtain or process any Billing Information.

4. Other Information

In addition to the Contact Information, and Volunteer/Intern Information, we may collect or receive the following information:

- From Your Activity. In an ongoing effort to improve the Site, and the Services, we automatically collect certain information when you visit the Site, and/or access and/or use our Services. This information consists of IP addresses, browser type and language, referring and exit pages and URLs, date and time, amount of time spent on particular pages, what sections of the Site you visit, and similar information concerning your use of the Site, and the Services ("Activity Information").
- From Cookies. We also collect Activity Information by using "cookie" technology. Cookies are small packets of data that a website stores on the hard drive of your computer or mobile device to "remember" information about your visit. We may use session cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent cookies (which stay on your computer/device until you delete them). If you do not want us to place a cookie on your hard drive, you may be able to turn that feature off on your computer or mobile device. Please consult your Internet browser's documentation for information on how to do this and how to delete persistent cookies. However, if you decide not to accept cookies from us, the Site, and the Services may not function properly.
- Third-Party Analytics. We may use one or more third—party analytics services to evaluate your use of the Site, and the Services, compile reports on activity (based on their collection of IP addresses, Internet service provider, browser type, operating system and language, referring and exit pages and URLs, data and time, amount of time spent on particular pages, what sections of the Site you visit, number of links clicked while on the Site, search terms and other similar usage data), and analyze performance metrics. These third parties use cookies and other technologies to help analyze and provide us the data. By accessing and using the Site, and/or the Services, you consent to the processing of data about you by these analytics providers in the manner and for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. How We Use and Share Your Information

You authorize us to use the Contact Information, Volunteer/Intern Information, and Other Information (collectively, the "Information") to provide our Site and Services to you, solicit your feedback, inform you about our products and services and those of our third-party marketing partners, and to improve the Site, and the Services. Also, we may use and share the Information as described below.

- <u>Agents, Providers and Related Third Parties</u>. We may engage other companies and individuals to perform certain business-related functions on our behalf. These other companies will have access to the Information only as necessary to perform their functions and to the extent permitted by law. We may also disclose aggregated user statistics in order to describe the Site and our Services to current and prospective business partners and to other third parties for other lawful purposes.
- <u>Business Transfers</u>. As we develop our businesses, we might sell or buy businesses or assets. In the event of a corporate sale, merger, reorganization, sale of assets, dissolution, or similar event, the Information may be part of the transferred assets.
- <u>Legal Requirements</u>. To the extent permitted by law, we may also disclose the Information: (i) when required by law, court order, or other government or law enforcement authority or regulatory agency; or (ii) whenever we believe that disclosing such Information is necessary or advisable, for example, to protect the rights, property, or safety of Act Now Foundation or others.
